We are all familiar with Habitat for Humanity and the homes that are built. But did you know that Habitat for Humanity has a reuse store located in downtown Lake Jackson at 12 Circle Way St? Habitat ReStores are independently owned reuse stores operated by local Habitat for Humanity organizations that accept donations and sell home improvement items to the public at a fraction of the retail price. They do not sell or accept clothing.

Habitat ReStore in Lake Jackson sells new and gently used furniture, appliances, home goods, building supplies, and more.

Volunteers are needed to help with cleaning, sorting and pricing items on Tuesdays from 9am-3pm. Volunteers are also needed on Thursdays & Fridays from 9am-3pm and Saturdays from 9am-noon to help in the backroom with sorting and pricing, assisting shoppers on the store floor, or working the cash register.
